Fun fact about Legal Deposit Regulation

Legal deposit is a legal requirement whereby a country (or region) submits a prescribed number of copies of their publications (national or local) to a national library or a central library.

The Macao Central Library is the Legal Deposit Library for all publications published within the Macao region.

Degree-Law No.72/89/M - Legal Deposit Regulation, as amended by Administrative Regulation No.10/2008

Significance

Legal deposit helps to preserve important cultural property by comprehensively collecting Macao Documents and making this local culture, memory and history available for study and utilize.



6 How to deliver publications?

Two physical copies of all Macao publications should be delivered to the Macao ISBN Agency of the Macao Central Library within five days of publication according to Macao law. The legal deposit submission procedure will then be completed.

Tips: Macao publications should be submitted for legal deposit within five days of publication!

Benefits of Legal Deposit for publishers



Permanent collection

The publications will be preserved properly, completely and systematically.



Effecting promotion and advertising

Readers around the world can have access to the relevant publications via the library collection catalogue or the joint collection search between the branch libraries and other libraries, thereby contributing to promotion and advertising of the publications

Higher utilisation

The publications can be accessed by more people through the platform of the Macao Public Library.

7 Is it possible to skip legal deposit. ?

Publishers or publishing organisations who fail to submit legal deposit copies in accordance with the regulation

shall be liable for a fine of MOP 200 to MOP 2,000.



9 Other considerations

Copyright page of all publications should indicate:

- Name of publisher
- Place and date of publication (year month)
- Name of printing company
- Place and date of printing (year month)

In accordance with Paragraph 2 of Article 8 of Legal Deposit Regulation (Degree-Law No. 72/89/M dated 31 October 1989), any publicly released publications failing to include all the aforementioned elements shall incur a fine of MOP 150 to MOP 1.500.

10 Preservation of deposited copies


