- Potsdamer Straße

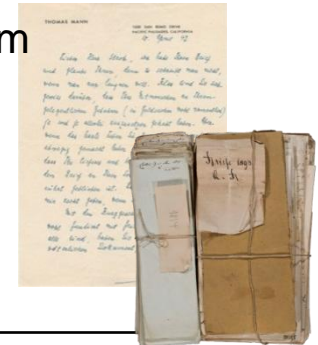


Holdings

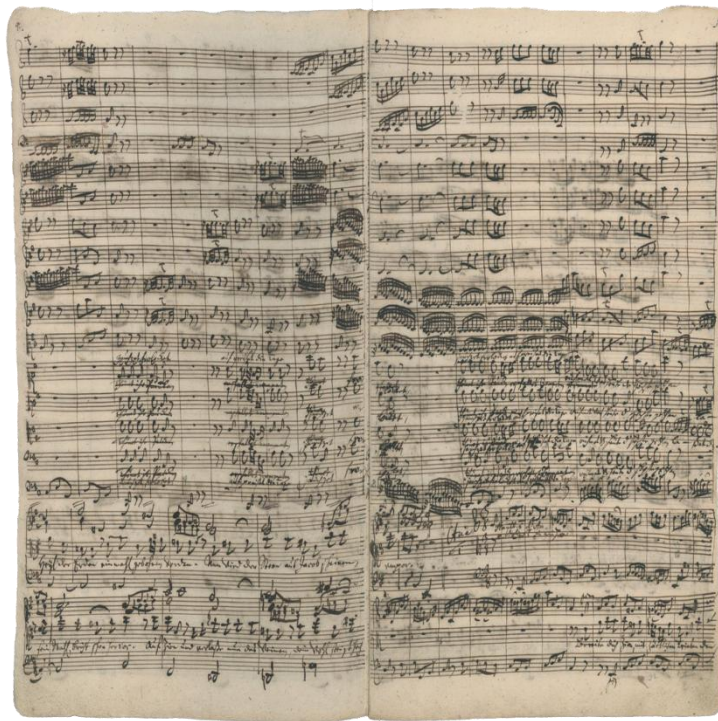

The Virtual Reconstruction of the Old
East Asia Collection of the Prussian
State Library

A generous grant allotted by the
German Federal Government and the cooperation with the Biblioteka
Jagiellońska in Krakow, Poland, enabled the Staatsbibliothek zu Berlin to take
first steps towards a virtual reconstruction of the old East Asia Collection of
the Prussian State Library.

The Staatsbibliothek zu Berlin and its East Asia collection

- 
- A map of East Asia, including China, Japan, and Korea, highlighted in red. The map is positioned behind the list of services.
- Acquisition of Chinese, Japanese and Korean material as a “national” service for all German academics
 - Cataloguing CJK material and offer records and data to other institutions / libraries in Germany
 - Offer access to the print collection via ILL services and one special and direct East Asia ILL services maintained by Staatsbibliothek
 - Organising access to electronic resources on and from East Asia which incl. also CNKI resources like CAJ, or dissertations and so on
 - Developing new licensing and business models in order to serve a user defined, research driven scientific community.

The Staatsbibliothek zu Berlin and its East Asia collection

- Development and running state of the art discovery service (research and content driven)
- Digitisation of Berlin copyright-free material and Asia related in all languages
- Development of virtual research environments (CrossAsia Campus)
- Internationalisation – which means developing a European perspective and supporting the European idea
- Planning and supporting “Digital Humanities” in the field of East Asia and China studies.

Licensing and organising access

CrossAsia licensing (since 2002):

- CrossAsia standard draft agreement (most rigorous requirements i.e. national but controlled and limited access, archiving & hosting rights, metadata, TDM)
- procedure: demands vs. costs and relevance
- further development: full-text index for print and e-material - even for non-licensed material

Result: + 1,7 Mio eBooks, access to CNKI, Wanfang, Airiti, 中國方志庫, 中國基本古籍庫 ..., NLC, ... more than 130 licensed databases

Digitisation

SSG 6,25 Digital (ongoing project)

The East Asia Department of the Berlin State Library has started to digitise selected parts of its holdings. The project is co-funded by the German Research Foundation (DFG) and encompasses five sections with materials in original languages: the Tibetan text collection of Waddell, one of the pioneers of Tibetology, the Manchu collection, the old Japan collection (Libri japonici), the old China collection (Libri sinici) and the collection of the German Sinologist Hähnisch. As a sixth part about 4000 titles of western language sources related to East and Southeast Asia published until 1912 will be digitised. Parts of the collections will be made searchable down to the chapter level. First results of the Western material can already be browsed and searched in the viewing environment of the "Digital collections" of the Staatsbibliothek zu Berlin.



Berlin-Kraków project

In 2013 important steps were made towards a virtual reconstruction of the old East Asia Collection of the Prussian State Library. Supported by a grant from the Commissary for Culture and Media (BKM) of the German Federal Government and in cooperation with the Biblioteka Jagiellońska in Krakow, Poland, the East Asia collection, which due to the war is nowadays housed at Krakow, was digitised in almost its entirety. Currently the collection is catalogued and the titles will then be presented in the Digital Collections of the State Library of Berlin.

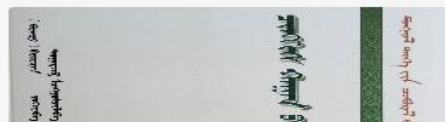
